On Tuesday, 4/11/06 at 0112 hrs. KPD dispatch received a call from Bryce Fisher reporting a domestic violence incident at their home involving himself and his wife ██████████. He reported to dispatchers that ██████████ had jumped on him and was now threatening to take the children and leave the residence.

Prior to my arrival, ██████████ also called KPD and did not leave with the children, ██████████.

I arrived with Ofc Knafla. I spoke to ██████████ who was with both her daughters. She was still talking with

KPD dispatch and appeared calm. She told me that she has known Bryce for 5 years and they have been married since October 2005. Bryce is currently a member of the Seattle Seahawks. She told me that they have had a number of problems lately, but the issue this evening was over information she received that he was having an affair [REDACTED]. She returned home about midnight and found Bryce in bed. She woke him and sat on the edge of the bed to ask him about his relationship with the other woman. He told her he didn't have to justify or explain his friendships to her and they began arguing. At some point [REDACTED] said that since he would not offer any information about the relationship, she would call the woman and ask herself. She said she reached down to the floor for his pants which had his cell phone, but when he realized what she was doing, he jumped out of bed and they both began struggling over the pants. Bryce then grabbed [REDACTED] by her right wrist/arm and twisted it behind her back in an arm lock and pushed her face down into the bed and took the pants away from her. This caused her pain since she had surgery on her right wrist in July 2005 to repair a torn tendon. She said she told him it hurt while he was twisting her wrist, but he replied that he was protecting his property. They continued to argue until [REDACTED] went downstairs to get her [REDACTED] daughter so that they could leave. She came back upstairs to get her [REDACTED], but Bryce had locked himself in the bathroom with her and refused to come out, knowing she would not leave without the [REDACTED]. Bryce then said he would call police and let them decide what to do.

After getting this story from [REDACTED], I conferred with Ofc Knafla who had been speaking with Bryce. The account Bryce gave Ofc Knafla was essentially the same in that there was a struggle over the pants and that he put her in an arm bar that by its nature requires a twisting of the arm and wrist which [REDACTED] complained of pain from.

Based on the comparison of the accounts given and the agreement that a struggle did in fact happen, and the physical size disparity and complaint of pain, I arrested Bryce Fisher for Assault/Domestic Violence. He was transported to KPD jail and booked by Ofc Knafla.

On 04-11-06, at approximately 0113 hours, I was dispatched to [REDACTED] with Cpl. Adair for a reported domestic disturbance. Dispatch advised that the reporting party was stating that his wife had jumped on him and was threatening to take the children and leave. The female then also called to report their disturbance.

Upon arrival, Bryce A. Fisher [REDACTED], opened the door. I spoke with Bryce while Cpl. Adair spoke with his wife, [REDACTED]. Also present was their [REDACTED] daughter in common, [REDACTED] daughter from a previous relationship, [REDACTED].

Bryce provided the following account. They have been married for 1 1/2 years and dated for over 4 years prior to their marriage. They have been having marital troubles lately and have recently been discussing whether they should stay together or not. They were arguing all day yesterday. Toady's argument started over [REDACTED] wanting

to talk about Bryce seeing other women. One of [REDACTED] friends told [REDACTED] that Bryce was with seeing another women. Bryce told [REDACTED] that he was not going to talk about anything like that. Bryce stated that [REDACTED] continued to press the issue but he would not talk about it. At about 2100 to 2300 hours, [REDACTED] left the residence. Bryce went to sleep with [REDACTED] was sleeping downstairs. [REDACTED] returned at around 0030 hours and confronted him again about the issue waking him and [REDACTED] up. He stated that [REDACTED] then went for his phone. He grabbed his pants that had his cell phone in the pocket to keep it away from [REDACTED]. She jumped on him trying to get the phone but he kept it away from her. He then took [REDACTED] into the bathroom and locked the door. [REDACTED] wanted to leave with the children. Bryce stated that he was not coming out of the bathroom. They both accused each other of scaring [REDACTED]. He eventually came out of the bathroom. When he did, [REDACTED] again jumped on him trying to get his cell phone. He stated that he put her in an, "arm bar" to get her to stop and to defend himself. He stated that she also slapped him in the face during the incident. I asked if he was injured from the incident and he stated no. I asked if [REDACTED] was injured from the incident. He stated that he did not believe so. He stated that he did not intend to hurt her and he did not believe he hurt her but that I could ask her. He then stated that the day before she jumped on his back, slapped him in the face, and kicked him in the, "nuts".

I did not observe any injuries on Bryce. I then spoke with Cpl. Adair and advised him of the account given by Bryce and of my observations. Cpl. Adair advised that [REDACTED] had a complaint of pain from the arm bar. There was also a significant physical difference between them. Bryce was 6' 03", 260 lbs. and is a professional athlete. [REDACTED] was 5' 05", 160 lbs.

Cpl. Adair advised Bryce that he was under arrest for Domestic Violence Assault. I placed Bryce in handcuff restraints. The restraints were checked for proper fit and double locked. He did not complain of any pain. I then transported Bryce to the City of Kirkland Jail for booking. Bryce requested to speak with a public defender. I contacted the public defender, [REDACTED] of Tucker and Stein, and Bryce was allowed a private consultation. Bryce was cooperative during the entire process.
