Sound Transit adopted the “Regional Transit Long-Range Vision” in 1996 and it is the general outline for a region-wide mass transit system. The system of improvements was to be built in voter-approved phases.

The 1996 Vision was based on over a decade of planning and environmental studies. Many changes have occurred in our area since it was adopted. Sound Transit is now going back to update our regional planning and environmental studies.
